



Driver Education Application/Agreement

This document will serve as an agreement between AC Driving School, the student, and the student parent(s).

1. Students must be *at least* 15 years old by the day they attend the course. (RCW 46.82.420)
2. Students must complete 34 hours of classroom instruction (includes 4 hrs of simulator instruction), five hours behind the wheel instruction, and up to five hours of observation. Students must complete lessons and the overall course with 80% accuracy. Work under 80% must be repeated. (WAC 308-108-120 (2c))
3. Parents *must* attend parent night for one (1) hour prior to their student attending class. (WAC 309-108-150 (8e))
4. Tuition and fees must be paid in full to receive a Traffic Safety Education Certificate.
5. Students will not be allowed to enroll after the third class period.
6. Students may withdraw from the class up to the third class period for a 75% refund. No refunds will be given after the third class period. Returned checks will be charge \$50.
7. In the event of failure to complete payment, A C Driving School, shall be entitled to attorney fees and other damages. The venue for any action shall be in the county of residence, State of Washington. An interest rate at 1.5% per month (18% per annum) will be paid on all past due accounts.
8. Legislation requires class instruction about organ donation options. Families may request alternate class work from an instructor during that portion of the class. (RCW 46.82.420)
9. Missed class sessions must be made up in order to maintain the concurrent order of learning. If a student misses more than three classes, they will be required to retake the course and pay again.
10. Regulations governing commercial driving schools dictate that the time from the beginning of a class to the issuing of a certificate be not less than 30 days, and no more than 180 days. (WAC 308-108-120 (2d))
11. Students not completing within two weeks of the last class period may be required to retake the class.
12. A student can be removed from the class for behavior problems, cheating, graffiti, defacing class materials, coming to class intoxicated or drug-induced condition.
In these cases, the student will not be permitted to return and there will be no tuition refund.
13. Use of tobacco products are prohibited within 500 ft. of A C Driving School classroom.
14. Any equipment that distracts a student from the instructor's presentation will be removed for the class period.
15. Families agree to provide opportunities for driving practice outside of this course.
16. Drives must be cancelled with at minimum a 24 hour notice to avoid a \$30 cancellation fee.
17. Students will be charged \$30 if they do not have their learner's permit at their scheduled drive lesson.
18. Students are expected to wait at the meeting location for at least 10 minutes after the scheduled start time.
19. Students that are in an intoxicated or drug induced condition will not drive and may be dropped from the course without refund. The use of tobacco products is *not allowed* while in the driving instruction car.
20. Once a student begins the driving phase, there will be no tuition refunds.
21. Student's cell phones will be placed in the center console during the entire driving lesson.
22. In order to apply for a license, a student must get an instruction permit and have it for 6 months, be at least 16 years old, successfully complete approved driver training course, complete at least 40 hours of daylight and 10 hours of night driving with someone who's been licensed for 5 or mor years.
23. Families will be responsible for providing coverage for their vehicle and permitted driver.

I agree to abide by the above conditions and guidelines. I realize that violations of these policies are grounds for dismissal from the course.

Intermediate Driver License Restrictions:

- For the first six months of driving, teen can't have passengers under the age of 20 except for family members.
- After six month, in addition to family members, up to three passengers under age 20 can also ride in the car.
- No late night driving between 1 a.m. & 5 a.m. The intermediate driver may only drive with a parent, guardian or other driver, who is at least 25 years old ride along.
